In view of the questionable residency status for Mrs. Matney and the fact that by this time her husband will have attained residence in the State of Washington, this is to request Morningside Hospital to remove Mrs. Matney from Convalescent Leave and place her upon Discharge status as soon as you can. It is our hope that if future hospitalization is necessary, this will be provided in the State of Washington rather than as a continuing cost to Alaska.

Although under Alaska law a woman may establish residence independent of her husband, Mrs. Matney's repeated return to her husband's home would indicate that such is not her desire.

We will appreciate your opinions on this matter.
